Environment Protection Department is responsible for administration of the laws and rules in order to provide for the protection, conservation, rehabilitation and improvement of the environment, for the sake of prevention and control of pollution.

Environmental protection aims to reduce the adverse impact on environment with the increase in industrialization and economic growth. There is both an impact on environment due to economic growth and impact of clean environment on economic growth. Thus, economic growth be sustainable in the sense that its impact on environment is minimal. Punjab Government's commitment towards environment protection envisions a clean, protected and safe environment for public that ensures environmental sustainability for future generations.
