GROWTH STRATEGY

Increasing Fish Productivity

- The department is intending to focus on productivity enhancement through increase per acre yield and vertical increase in farming area to have maximum sustainable yield both from natural and manmade resources.
- To achieve the desired strategic goals and objectives it is quite necessary to give importance to the research and development, better extension service conservation, management of natural resources training and education and provision of adequate quantity of quality fish seed.
- However, there is also necessary to focus on establishment of modern fish market, provision of cold chain and value addition as well as product development to get handsome profit from the fisheries business through domestic and export marketing. Beside this the challenges of high electricity cost and load shedding which is un-avoidable and may be destroyed for farming sector in future as per unit cost (Kg) is being increasing rapidly causing reduction in net financial benefit to the fish farmers. Therefore, it has been desired in the strategy to reduce

- electricity cost through alternated energy sources for operation and management of tubewell and other installation etc.
- Besides it has been desired under the strategy to introduce intensive culture, high value fish species, fish culture in saline & brackish water bodies, development of mini and small dams as well as other natural resources etc.
