<b>Project Name</b>	Access To Clean Energy Investment Program
<b>Project Cost</b>	ADB Loan: \$ 83.69 M.
<b>Background</b>	The Loan Agreement was signed on 7 <sup>th</sup> February, 2017 and declared effective on 7 <sup>th</sup> May 2017 and project closing date is 30 <sup>th</sup> June 2023. Total funding of Asian Development Bank is USD 325 million being implemented in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and Punjab. The share of Punjab is USD 83.69 million. This is Result Based Lending Programme.

<b>Project Objective</b>	To support implementation of Punjab Power Sector Programme in increasing access to sustainable and more reliable electricity services particularly for the vulnerable communities.
