The undersigned is directed to state that Government of People's Republic of China has invited nominations for subject Bilateral Seminar for Government officials. The Program is funded by the Chinese Government and the Government of Pakistan will not be liable for any costs thereof. The final date of the seminar will be decided later. The requisite qualification and general requirements are as under:-

a. Eligibility Criteria

- Officers (BS-17 & above / Permanent only) of Ministries / Divisions / Attached Departments and Provincial Governments most relevant to the training programmes.
- Maximum age limit is 50 years for BS 20 & above, and 45 years for BS 17-19.
- Be in good health and free from any infectious disease with health certificate.
- Proficiency in English.
- Passport having minimum validity of six months.
- **Contract Employees are not eligible**

b. Expenses

The following expenses are to be borne by the Chinese Government.

- Round-trip air tickets
- Transit allowance
- Boarding and Lodging
- Daily Allowance of 60-80 RMB

c. Documents Required

The following documents (02 sets of each) are required to be sent alongwith the nomination:

- Application Form
- Information Form duly filled in by the nominee.
- FTC Proforma.
- Two copies of valid passport.
- Copy of CNIC.
- Medical Certificate (Foreigner Physical Examination Form)
- Surety Bond
- Undertaking


