OFFICE MEMORANDUM

SUBJECT: - Training Course on “Fundamentals of Environmental Immunotoxicology and Reproductive Toxicology from 10-14 November, 2025 at Chulabhorn Research Institute, Bangkok, Thailand

The undersigned is directed to inform that the Governments of Thailand has invited nominations for the above **Fully Funded** training course. The brochure and application form of the subject training course is available at www.ead.gov.pk.

2. The eligibility criteria and objectives of the subject course are as under:

Eligibility Criteria

- Be Permanent Government employee (BS-17 and above) nominated by the respective Federal Ministry or Provincial Department.
- Participants should have some basic knowledge on the biology of the immune and reproductive systems, as well as methodologies for assessing the functioning of these systems.
- Proficient in English;
- In good health

Objective

- To understand blood cells and the mammalian immune system, including the three arms of immune response.
- To learn how toxic chemicals, affect immune system homeostasis and health outcomes.
- To gain skills in cellular and functional methods to assess immunotoxicity.
- To recognize links between immunotoxicology, drug development, and risk assessment.
- To understand hormonally active agents, their actions, and health impacts.
- To learn routes of exposure, bioaccumulation, distribution, and metabolism of such agents.
- To study methods to assess chemical effects on the reproductive system.

3. Nomination of suitable candidates duly approved by the competent authority along with the following documents may kindly be forwarded to this Ministry latest by **25th August, 2025** positively.
