OFFICE MEMORANDUM

SUBJECT: 2025 CAPACITY BUILDING TRAINING PROGRAMS OF SOUTH SOUTH COOPERATION ON CLIMATE CHANGE

The undersigned is directed to state that the Government of the People's Republic of China has offered two Training Programs of South-South Cooperation on Climate Change ([List and details attached](#)). The Chinese side has further informed that candidates **cannot be withdrawn, once nominated**, and the final application result will be subject to the MOFCOM. The Government of Pakistan will not be liable to bear any cost. The requisite general requirements are as under:

Eligibility Criteria

- Officers (**BS-17 & above**) of Ministries / Divisions and Provincial Governments most relevant to the training programmes.
- Proficiency in English.
- **Maximum age limit is 55 years for BS 20 & above, and 45 years for BS 17-19.**
- **Contract Employees are not eligible**

Documents Required

The following documents are required to be sent along with the nomination:

- [Application Form attached](#) (**02 sets**)
- Copy of Passport at least six months of remaining validity and blank visa pages (**02 sets**)
- Medical Certificate (Foreigner Physical Examination Form) (**02 sets**)
- No criminal record certificate or Police Clearance Certificate attested by Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Pakistan, if not visited China within 5 years (**02 sets**)
- Proof of English proficiency
- Proof of Work Experience and Relevant Qualifications
- FTC Proforma
- Copy of CNIC
- Surety Bond on stamp paper
- Undertaking on stamp paper

3. Nominations of suitable candidates fulfilling the eligibility criteria, duly approved by the competent authority, may be forwarded to this Division by **May 5, 2025, positively**. The relevant Ministries / Divisions and Provincial P & D Departments must note the following points while nominating the candidates:

1. Most relevant candidates should be nominated for Scholarship programmes.
2. Nomination of candidates should reach MoEA before the deadline. Late arrival of nomination after the MoEA's deadline will not be entertained.
3. Nomination papers, complete in all respects, may be forwarded to EAD through proper channel i.e. through their respective Administrative Ministry / Division/ P&D Department.
4. All candidates must follow code of conduct ([Annex-I](#))

4. In order to the avail trainings programs, it may be ensured that suitable nominations, along with their complete documents, are provided to this Ministry **before the closing date**.

Requirements for trainees	Work field	Government officials at the Director General/Director in the field of environment and climate change; the experts and technical personnel involved in climate change policy formulation and international negotiations.
	Age	The age of the Director General/Deputy Director General level personnel SHALL NOT exceed 55 years old, and the Director level personnel and below SHALL NOT exceed 45 years old.
	Health	Be in good health, demonstrated by a health certificate or medical examination form issued by a local public hospital within the past year. No diseases prohibited by Chinese laws and regulations, no serious hypertension, cardiovascular diseases, diabetes and other serious chronic diseases, no mental diseases or infectious diseases that may cause significant harm to public health, non-major postoperative recovery period and acute onset period, non-disability, non-pregnancy.
	Language competence	Good English listening, speaking, reading and writing skills
	Others	Trainees shall not bring spouses or relatives or friends to China during the training period. Chinese government shall not bear the cost of your spouse or relatives in China. While in China, you shall not participate in activities not related to the training; you shall follow the schedule of training strictly and get the permission before you make a change by yourself. You shall bear the consequences due to violation of the regulations by yourself.
	Application materials	1. Application Form: Please complete the application form electronically. If a handwritten version is submitted, please also provide an electronic version. 2. Physical Examination Report (in Chinese or English): In case of any

		discrepancy found with the physical examination results, the candidate's qualification shall be revoked. The candidate shall bear all adverse consequences and additional expenses arising therefrom. 3. Scanned Copy of Passport. 4. Proof of English Proficiency (highly recommended, but not required). 5. Proof of Work Experience and Relevant Qualifications (not required).
