OFFICE MEMORANDUM

SUBJECT: MULTILATERAL TRAINING PROGRAMS IN AGRICULTURE AREA UNDER CHINA AID IN NOVEMBER 2025

The undersigned is directed to state that the Government of the People's Republic of China has offered Multilateral training programs, in agriculture area, for the month of November 2025 for officers of the Government of Pakistan ([List](#) and program [details](#) are attached). The Chinese side has further informed that the **candidates cannot be withdrawn, once nominated, and the final application result will be subject to the MOFCOM**. The Government of Pakistan will not be liable to bear any cost. The requisite general requirements are as under:

Eligibility Criteria

- Officers (BS-17 & above) of Ministries / Divisions and Provincial Governments most relevant to the training programs.
- Proficiency in English.
- Under 45 for officials at or under director's level; Under 50 for officials at director general's level
- **Contract Employees are not eligible**

Documents Required

The following documents are required to be sent alongwith the nomination:

- Application Form with personal signature and photo (**Original & Copy**)
- Information Form with personal signature and photo (**Original & Copy**)
- Copy of Passport with at least six months of remaining validity and blank visa pages
- Foreign Physical Examination Form with personal photo (**Original & Copy**)
- No criminal record certificate or Police Clearance Certificate, attested by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Pakistan, if not visited China within past 5 years or non-availability of official passport
- FTC Proforma
- Copy of CNIC
- Surety Bond on stamp paper (**Original**)
- Undertaking on stamp paper (**Original**)
- No Objection Certificate (**Provide within two days after selection**)

2. The relevant Ministries / Divisions and Provincial P & D Departments must note the following points while nominating the candidates:

1. Most relevant candidates should be nominated for the training programs.
2. Nomination of the candidates should reach EAD before the deadline. Late arrival of nomination, after EAD's deadline, will not be entertained.
3. Nomination papers, complete in all respects, should be forwarded to EAD through proper channel i.e. through the respective Administrative Ministry / Division/ P&D Department.
4. All candidates must follow the code of conduct ([Annex-I](#)).

About the Organizer	<p>Inner Mongolia Agricultural University (IMAU) is a multi-disciplinary university with a focus on agriculture and forestry, characterized by grassland animal husbandry, and eight disciplines including agriculture, engineering, science, economics, management, humanities, law, and arts. It has a complete higher education system for cultivating vocational colleges, bachelor's, master's, and doctoral students. In 2001, it became a key university supported by the "One Province, One University" in the national western development. In 2012, it became a "provincial and ministerial co construction" university jointly established by the State Forestry Administration (now the State Forestry and Grassland Administration) and the People's Government of the autonomous region. In 2013, it entered the ranks of supporting universities in the national "Central and Western Higher Education Revitalization Plan". Inner Mongolia Agricultural University is the earliest university in Inner Mongolia to carry out education for foreign students and exchange of visiting scholars. It has established intercollegiate cooperation and academic exchange relationships with more than 70 universities and research institutions from more than 20 countries, including the United Kingdom, the United States, Canada, Australia, Russia, Japan, and Mongolia, and has rich experience in training and managing international students and technical personnel. The teaching infrastructure, teaching equipment, textbooks, teachers, laboratories, internship bases, and other teaching conditions for international students and foreign technical personnel training are complete. There are specialized foreign experts and student buildings provided for international students, and the accommodation environment and medical system are very perfect. More than 700 experts and professors from abroad have come to the university for academic exchange, visiting lectures, scientific research cooperation, and other activities. The school has set up the "the Belt and Road" Research Institute, and participated in the "the Belt and Road" education foreign aid projects, academic exchanges and scientific research cooperation.</p> <p>In 2012, the school became the designated institution for China-aided training programs held by the Ministry of Commerce and is also the only university in Inner Mongolia Autonomous Region to undertake such projects. It has organized 35 sessions of multilateral and bilateral China-aided training and trained a total of 938 participants from 60 countries. - (4) Hasisurong: doctor, professor, doctoral supervisor; research interests: veterinary pharmacokinetics, pharmacology of natural active substances, veterinary clinical pharmacology, and parasitology of ruminant animals.
- (5) Wang Rui: doctor, professor, doctoral supervisor; research interests: biological control mechanism and preparation of animal diseases, resistance mechanism of parasites, detection of parasitic infections, plant resistant components and molecular biology and bioinformatics.

It is planned to arrange the participants to learn Chinese, experience the historical culture of Hangzhou, visit ancient cultural blocks, and appreciate China's profound traditional culture.

CODE OF CONDUCT

1. Adhere to the laws of the People's Republic of China and the relevant regulations outlined in the relevant seminar / training.
2. While the Chinese government upholds the freedom of religion, it is important to note that foreigners are prohibited from distributing religious propaganda material or engaging in activities that aim to recruit followers.
3. In case of an emergency, please promptly inform the staff for immediate assistance.
4. Please ensure the safety of your personal belongings and consider storing them in the hotel if needed.
5. If you have any specific dietary requirements, kindly inform the staff as soon as possible.
6. When visiting scenic spots and historical sites, please be attentive to signs indicating that photography is not allowed.
7. Please observe Chinese laws and Regulations during your stay. Especially the norms of “sexual harassment” can be different from your country’s. Please avoid inappropriate and undesirable situations, which can lead to the termination of your program and draw legal consequences. Acts, conversation, correspondence, emails, gestures that can be construed as harassment must be strictly avoided.
8. You are not allowed to work, because you receive living allowance from China and the purpose of your stay in China is to engage in study / research.
9. Universally courtesy and politeness costs nothing and only earn friends. It is always beneficial to be courteous and polite. Politeness is not a sign of weakness. It shows good breeding, education and upbringing.
10. Female colleagues must be respected. They are fellow officers. Some very basic things shall be considered while interacting with the female colleagues:
 - Generally, as a mark of respect, one should stand when a female enters a room.
 - Personal space should be respected during conversation and a comfortable distance should be maintained.
 - Personal remarks on their dress and appearance should be avoided.
 - Loose language or inappropriate terms should not be used.
 - Inappropriate jokes should not be cracked.

- Hand gestures universally deemed obscene should not be made.
- Staring should be strictly avoided.
- Situations that make female colleagues uncomfortable should be avoided.
- While talking to a female, hands should never be placed in trousers pockets.
- Personal questions should never be asked (age, height, weight, marital status etc).
- Ordinarily, men should open the door for women.
- Females should always precede a male while entering a room.
- Door of a car should be opened for a female colleague.

11. Psychological harassment is against Chinese norms, that shall strictly be avoided:

- a. Persistent, unjustified and unnecessary negative attacks on personal or professional performance;
- b. Manipulation of an employee's personal or professional reputation by rumor, gossip or ridicule;
- c. Offensive comments or behavior relating to the ethnic origin, physical characteristics or religion of an individual;
- d. Exclusion or continued isolation from professional activities;
