Course Objective:

The government agencies or electric power utilities those are responsible for hydropower development acquire knowledge about hydropower development and relevant experiences in Japan.

Eligibility Criteria: -

The applicant should:

- Be responsible for hydropower development and those currently posted to the managerial position in the government agencies or electric power utilities which are in charge of the development of hydropower generation.
- Have at least 5 years of practical experience in the field of hydropower development.
- Be graduate of engineering university.
- Be between the ages of 30 and 50 years.
- Female are encouraged to apply for the training course.
