
Subject: RESTRICTION ON PROJECT REVISION AFTER SUBMISSION OF PC-IV DOCUMENTS TO DGM&E, P&D BOARD

Please refer to the captioned subject cited above.

It is observed with concern that after submission of Project Completion Report (PC-IV) to Directorate General (M&E) and during evaluation process some of the projects have not successfully achieved results as per their designed scope; and departments tend to revise projects (time and cost) without taking Directorate General (M&E) into loop.

2. It is to clarify that the revision of development projects after submission of PC-IV documents is against the norms of Planning Commission Guidelines and Planning Manual 2015, wherein it is spelled out that after submission of project completion document (PC-IV), there would be no revision.

3. In the light of above, it is reiterated that after submission of PC-IV documents to DGM&E, projects would be treated as completed and concluded in all respects and there would be no revision allowed.
