Course Objective:


Through this program, participants are expected to acquire basic knowledge on the necessary planning for sewerage and urban stormwater drainage.

Eligibility Criteria:-

The applicant should:

- Be relatively inexperienced technical officers engaged in sewerage works in governments' organization.
- Be university graduates or equivalent
- Have more than 3 years' experience in sewerage works and / or development of urban sanitation infrastructure.
- Be under age of 49 years.
- Women are encouraged to apply for the training.
