SUBJECT: - **Training Course on "Supply Chain Resilience", to be conducted in-person in Singapore from 16 to 20 June 2025 under the Japan-Singapore Partnership Programme for the 21st Century (JSPP21)**

The undersigned is directed to inform that the Governments of Singapore and Japan have invited nominations for the above **Fully Funded** training course. The brochure of the subject training course is available at **www.ead.gov.pk**.

2. The eligibility criteria and objectives of the subject course are as under:

Eligibility Criteria

- Be Government employees (BS-17 and above) nominated by the respective Federal Ministry or Provincial Department.
- Mid-to-senior level government officials involved in developing strategies and implementing policies on supply chain resilience for their country;
- Proficient in written and spoken English; and
- In good health.

Objective

- This programme will discuss the impact of recent major events on global supply chains and share our approach in strengthening supply chain resilience.

3. Nomination of suitable candidates duly approved by the competent authority along with the following documents may kindly be forwarded to this Ministry latest by **March 25, 2025** positively. Interested officers are requested to apply online at **https://go.gov.sg/scr2025** as required by Singapore (Mandatory). **Nomination without online application will not be considered by the host.**
